Plant Ecology: For all ages. Plants are fun! Learn all about plant parts, how seeds travel and some of their many neat adaptations and facts!

Birding 101: For all ages. Learn about the birds of the area. What they eat, how they nest and observe them in flight.

Wetland Bingo: For all Ages. Open your eyes and ears to the wonders of nature while you search for plants & animals on your bingo sheet.

Life of a Honey Bee: For all Ages. Learn about the life cycle of honey bees and how important they are as pollinators.

We will provide a space for backpacks to be stored. Washrooms and a water bottle refill station are located inside the building.

Our grounds are available if you need to have lunch or a snack, there are garbage's and recycling throughout. In case of bad weather indoor space is limited and cannot be guaranteed.
